Kia ora te whānau,

It is with genuine and heartfelt thanks that we wish to reach out to you all today after Celia's untimely passing a week ago. The tributes, flowers, plants, food, texts, emails, visits and phone calls have given us strength and courage. We are still being fed glorious morning teas and spoilt with care packages.

In our eulogy, we paid tribute to Celia and her dedication to the teaching profession. She taught at CAS for five years, the first three in the Year Four - Seven Level and then most recently releasing classroom teachers from Years One - Eight. I recounted her last morning on June 11th where she had been teaching in two Junior rooms, enjoying her time with the students. Celia was a highly reflective teacher and paid great attention to detail often pointing out the finer details of events and organisation that we may have missed.

Collingwood Area School was honoured to be able to play an important role at the funeral. Claire read the English translation of one of Celia's favourite waiata, Parea Nei:

"Scattered by the wind, washed by the rain, and transformed by the sun, all doubts are swept away and all restraints cast down. Fly o free spirit, fly to the clouds in the heavens transformed by the sun, with all doubts swept away and restraints cast down. Yes all restraints cast down".

The students then stood and sung this waiata.

We will all have lifelong memories and images of the students performing a resounding haka in the Main Street of Collingwood then the power of the silence once that haka had ended. It was a real moment of reflection and respect and a very fitting tribute to a highly regarded teacher.
